I asked 18 women, of different ages & from various backgrounds; "WHAT 'LINES' DO YOU DRAW, AS A WOMAN?"

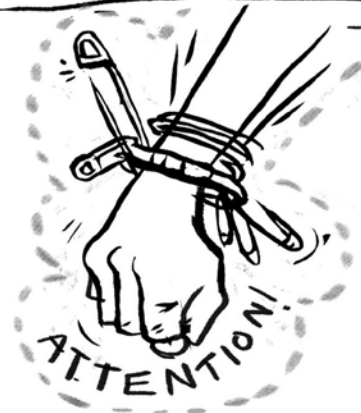
